

Rail Europe is now selling Eurail mobile Passes

Travellers will have to download an app and enter their name and pass number-. In the app, travellers create day tickets for each trip they make and that they show to the ticket inspectors. This procedure in the app replaces the paper travel diary that was used with the paper Eurail Pass.

Rail Europe will train its travel agent partners in order for them to offer this new product. Dedicated videos, webinars and training modules will be deployed in the coming weeks.
